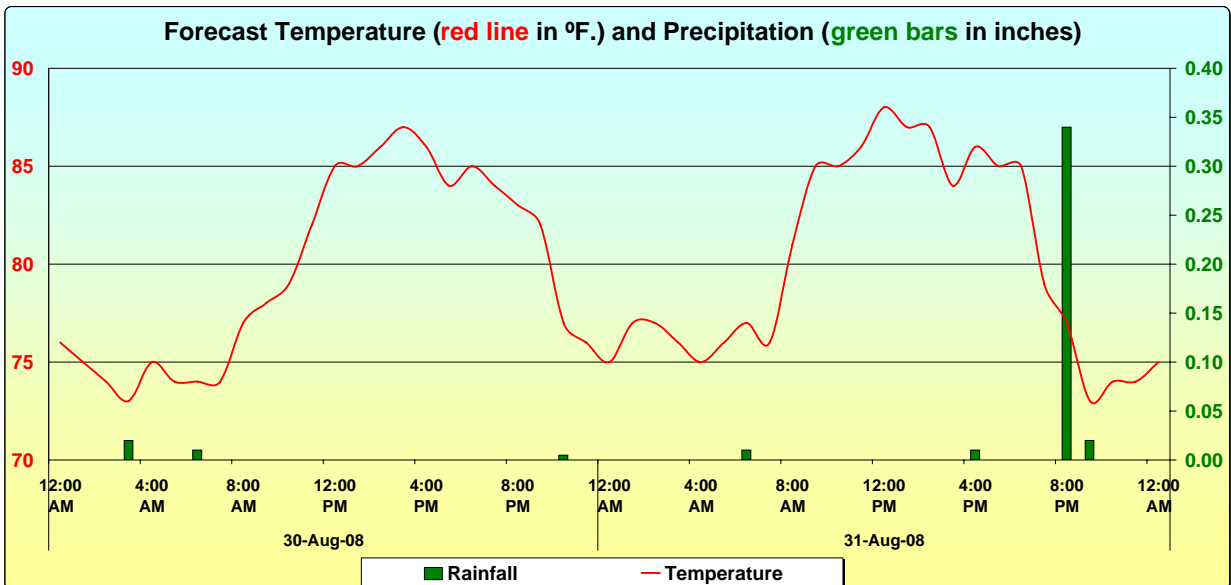

Mother Nature's bark is sometimes much worse than Her bite -- and this is a typical day for that: it 'looks bad' at first glance, but the brief lightning shows at 3 am, 6 am, and again at 10 pm that develop in the region will likely pass to the distant east with nothing more than a few drops of rain for this exact location. Otherwise, a nice morning will be followed by hazy PM sunshine with dewpoints reaching 76F.				The atmosphere will very likely be increasingly unstable today. After a quick sprinkle around sunrise, full clearing will provide for lots of sunshine, yet right around three in the afternoon is when increasingly darker clouds will roll-in. Expect a bit of thunder to develop soon thereafter, but the downpours associated with the storm cells won't probably occur until closer to sunset and into the mid-eve hours.
